The Alaska Average Weekly Wage (AAWW), determined by the Commissioner of the Department of Labor and Workforce Development, and applicable for the period of January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024, is \$1,232.

The maximum compensation rate under AS 23.30.175(a) is 120% of the AAWW, which is \$1,478.

The minimum compensation rate under AS 23.30.175(a) is 22% of the maximum compensation rate, which is \$325.

The maximum compensation rate under AS 23.30.041(k) is 105% of the AAWW, which is \$1,294.
